


David Bonnier:

"It is clear that the real big money will come only when cannabis becomes legal for recreational use."


"It is a market large enough to attract what the researcher Johan Edman calls the 'addiction for profit industry', companies and individuals who are driven by making money and who also have political influence. A force that could tip the scales in a more liberal direction. Tax money is also in the same balance. If some EU countries start collecting tax money on cannabis, it will be difficult for others to resist."

"The market already exists. There are customers, there is demand. From my role as an investor, this is a completely different opportunity. I can calculate roughly how big the market is in different countries. We think about this all the time. How should we do if we are going to bet on this and above all: how do we do it damn fast, because you have to be early."

Household Spenditures on Medical and Recreational Cannabis in Canada 2010-2022




Projected growth of European cannabis market











Past 12 Months and Daily/Near Daily Cannabis Use in Colorado, Canada and Sweden, 2021




Past 12 Months Cannabis Use and Illicit and Legal Cannabis Market in Colorado, Canada and Sweden




